#### CdR - KCC RECIPROCAL AGREEMENT

In order to foster a better relationship between our two clubs, a reciprocal arrangement between KCC and CdeR was signed and accepted as an agreement by both parties and is effective 1st July 2022.

CdeR members can enjoy the dining facility at KCC's Boundary Cafe restricted to Mondays to Thursdays (except Holidays) any time after 7 pm, restrictions on numbers also apply. In turn KCC members can enjoy the use of our Tennis facilities at off-peak times with maximum of two courts allowed. Agreed fees are charged.

This arrangement is made with consideration that the membership of both Clubs are least inconvenienced.

For CdeR members to make use of the dining facilities at KCC's Boundary Cafe, bookings must be made with our office stating numbers in the group. A member is limited to include 5 guests in his/her party.

KCC allows a maximum of 10 (ten) persons per day. Charges will be made to the account of the member who made the booking and will be passed to CdeR for settling.
