Pickleball Rules and Regulations

1. Players should observe the rules of the game set up by the International Federation of Pickleball (IFP).
2. Players should use proper playing equipment to play this game.
3. Proper Pickleball attire should be worn at all times when playing on the courts. No leather shoes are to be worn in playing the game. Shoes with dark coloured soles which may cause markings on the courts are not permitted.
4. Members should always exercise courtesy on court.
5. Members should sign the chit before playing. Those who fail to sign on the same day will be fined \$50. Frequent offenders may receive warning letter and be suspended from using the court for a period of time.
6. Members can book a court for two consecutive hours at one time but cannot book any court for other members.
7. Courts can be booked in person or by calling the office from 10am to 1pm and 2pm to 7pm.
8. Members can cancel the booking by giving a prior notice of 24 hours. Booking can be cancelled due to heavy rain one hour before the scheduled booking time.
9. Court fee can be waived if it rains within the first 30 minutes after the starting time.
10. Members can bring along three guest players to play this game, subject to review by the Convenor. Guest fee will be charged at the same time when the court fee is being debited.
11. Non members, other than those governed by Articles 41 and 55 hereof, shall be permitted to enter the Club house in the company of a Member but this privilege shall not be exercised in the case of any one visitor more often than twice during any one month or eight times in one year, and their names must be entered in the Visitors Book provided for that purpose. (**Refer to Memorandum and Articles of Association of the Club De Recreio*)
12. Children under 12 must be supervised and accompanied by their parents or designated adults.
13. Any matches played in the name of the Club must obtain prior approval of the Convenor.
14. Food and drinks (except water) are not allowed to be consumed inside the court.
15. Cigarette smoking is prohibited except at the designated smoking area of the Club.
16. Chairs and stools are not allowed to be taken into the court.
17. Members should not abuse the use of the Club's equipment and facilities.
18. Members should not enter the court before the booked time and should leave immediately when the booked time ends.
19. Any member who is found playing on an un-booked court is breaching the Club regulations and will be liable to a fine and subject to possible disciplinary action.
20. Only members with written approval from the General Committee are allowed to conduct professional coaching with additional charge payable to the Club. Those who fail to observe the rule are liable to a fine of \$1,000 and subject to possible disciplinary action.

Members who fail to observe the above rules and regulations will be warned and may be suspended to use the pickleball facilities for a period of time as determined by the Convenor and the Sub-Committee members.
