Social Distancing measures eased

With further Social Distancing measures eased as announced by the Chief Executive of HKSAR and as directed by the Home Affairs Bureau of the HK Government, the General Committee is pleased to announce the following updated measures to become effective Friday May 8th:

❖ Dining and Bar:

- Dining tables may seat a maximum of 8 persons.
- Our Bar area can serve alcoholic beverages with maximum of 4 to a table.
- Members if they wish can bring in their own alcoholic beverages subject to corkage charge and limitation already set by the club.

❖ Showers and Changing Rooms

- The Shower Facilities will re-open but only with alternate cubicles in use.
- Only 8 persons at any one time will be allowed in the Changing Rooms.

❖ Sports & Recreation Facilities.

- For Lawn Bowls, a maximum of 8 players will be allowed to a rink. Non-players should not hang around the green if total capacity of the green is reached.
- For Tennis and Badminton, apart from the 4 players involved in the game, others who are waiting their turn in the court should not exceed 8 and subject to the discretion of the Convenor.



CLUB DE RECREIO

- The Card Rooms will not be available for use until Monday May 11 due to it being used as additional dining facilities for the days leading up to Mother's Day. Due to constraints set by Social Distancing Policies, only 3 tables will be set in each of the rooms. Face Masks is a prerequisite in the Card Rooms.

❖ **Social Distancing Rules applicable to the club in General.**

- Body temperature will be taken at the entrance to the club for anyone wishing to enter the premises, however it is not necessary to complete the Health Declaration form.
- Anyone who is not wearing a Face Mask will be prohibited from entering the premises.
- Face Mask must be worn in most areas of the club unless you are eating or drinking and while you are playing Sports.

With the new measures in place it is at least a step forward in having our facilities return to normal. Hopefully in two weeks' time if the situation in HK improves, more restrictions may be lifted. We are thankful that Club de Recreio, with your support is doing its part in combatting this pandemic.
